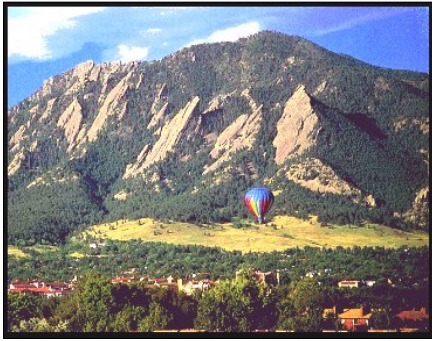


# A day found only in Boulder...

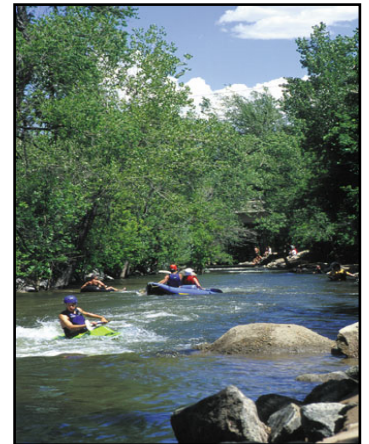

### Why You Should Visit and Explore Boulder...

- More than 300 sunny days a year (More than San Diego or Miami!)
- Recently rated the "#1 Sports Town in America" by *Outside Magazine*, offering countless year-round recreational activities. Take advantage of the 200 miles of public hiking and biking trails, approximately 30,000 acres of open space or the 16-mile Boulder Creek Path, which runs through the middle of town.
- More than 30 art galleries, 4 local museums, 32 movie & stage theaters and many festivals.
- Four block pedestrian-only mall, known as "Pearl Street". "Pearl Street" includes a variety of outdoor cafes, restaurants, coffee houses, and street performers, all of which liven up the mall's atmosphere day and night.
- Unique performance venues, such as the historic Boulder Theatre, The Fox Theater, Chautauqua Music Hall, Mary Rippon Theater and Macky Auditorium provide intimate settings for Boulder's annual Shakespeare, Bach, Dance and Music Festivals, as well as live concerts by well-known performers.
- Close by, there are four golf courses and three city-owned and operated state-of-the-art recreation centers, including more than 40 tennis courts.
- Within 30 miles, there is Rocky Mountain National Park and Eldora Mountain Ski Area and Nordic Center. Under 65 miles, there are a variety of dude and guest ranches, historic gambling towns, such as Black Hawk and Central City, and Winter Park Ski Resort. Under 95 miles, there are the ski resort communities of Summit County and Vail
