AREA ATTRACTIONS:

Boulder Dushanbe Teahouse: The Teahouse is a gift from Boulder's sister city, Dushanbe, Tajikistan. It is the only one of its kind in the Western Hemisphere and features an eclectic, international menu and teas from all over the world.

Celestial Seasonings Tea Company: Celestial Seasonings offers a free, 45-minute factory tour of the tea making process and art gallery.

Leanin' Tree Museum of Western Art: Visit the museum and see the largest, privately held collection of western art in the country!

Chautauqua Park Historic District: Located at the base of the Flatiron Mountains, Chautauqua offers many features for the person who wants a little bit of everything. There are playgrounds, hiking trails, fantastic views, entertainment, the historic Dining Hall, the Chautauqua Summer Festival and the Colorado Music Festival.

Pearl Street Mall: The outdoor, pedestrian mall offers boutiques, restaurants, sidewalk cafés and bookstores. Seasonal attractions include art shows, craft fairs, music, and street performers.

Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art: This gallery features exhibits from local and visiting artists.

Boulder Brewing Company: See the brewing process and sample brews in the country's oldest operating microbrewery.

Boulder Creek Path: The path runs next to the Boulder Creek for nine miles. It's great for hiking, biking, running, and people watching. Parks along the way are perfect for Frisbee and picnics.

Boulder Reservoir: The reservoir is perfect for sunbathing, swimming, and boating. There's even a beach!

Flagstaff Mountain: A drive up Flagstaff Mountain gives you spectacular views of Boulder, the Front Range, and the Continental Divide.

Galleries Galore: Visit one of Boulder's 30 galleries to experience art from more than 85 Colorado artists.

Rocky Mountain National Park: It's only a 45-minute drive to experience Colorado's breathtaking beauty and wildlife.

29th Street Mall: A nearby pedestrian mall featuring a wide variety of stores and restaurants.
